


- Prayer at the kneeler

On behalf of THRIVE Peninsula's staff and board of directors, we sincerely thank you for your donation of **45 pounds of food** on **7-22-22**, which will provide 37 meals to our Peninsula neighbors in need.

Thanks to supportive congregations like yours, in 2021, THRIVE provided 1 weeks' worth of groceries to 8,325 people, which includes 3,069 children. Nearly 40% of these households accessed services at THRIVE for the first time. So many families in our community have never had to ask for help before, but now struggle to secure childcare or face the increased costs of housing, gas, and food. It is our goal to make sure, despite these challenges, that no one in our community will go hungry.
