

It is with great sadness that we announce that Rev. Coretha Loughridge, wife of former HCC Interim Minister, Rev. Johnny Loughridge has passed away.



After a two year battle with cancer, Coretha Renee Gilmer Loughridge, died on Friday morning, December 8th, 2023.

We celebrate these days because of the life that has been loving and compassionate for 65 years. You may have not known her all of those 65 years, but whether you knew her for a day, a year, or a lifetime, she undoubtedly had an impact on you, as you on her, and you could count her a friend and ally.

Coretha was born and raised in Pulaski, VA and proud of it! She started her educational journey at Radford University, then went on to Lynchburg College, where she graduated Cum Laude. She ultimately received her Masters of Divinity from Vanderbilt University, and thus was ordained into the Ministry of Jesus Christ within the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ).

She began her ministerial journey in Kansas City, and then returned to Virginia where she pastored Boons Mill CC (DoC) for 16 1/2 years. Her judicatory leadership began in Texas, serving in Administrative Ministry to the Southwest Region, as well as an Assistant Area Minister to the North Texas Area. Then she was Area Minister in East Texas for 10 years and 2 more as Interim Regional Minister in the Southwest.

She returned to her home state of Virginia serving as Interim Regional Minister in the Christian Church, (DoC). After which, she returned to the parish ministry for three years at Fairview Christian Church, (DoC), Lynchburg, Va. She retired May 1st 2023.

Throughout her lifetime, Coretha contributed 1000s of hours to her communities as a person who cared. Charities and groups such as, but not limited to, YMCA, CASA, Special Olympics, immigrants, LBGTQ+ community, homeless, veterans, and anyone else who required care and attention from a compassionate Church and soul. Coretha inspired many women and men to enter the ministry of the Christian Church, (Disciples of Christ). That is and will forever be her legacy.

Coretha was preceded in death by her parents, Jack and Coretta Gilmer, as well as a brother and sister who died in birth. Coretha was survived by her son, Paul Morra, his children Gabriel and Mila, Step-daughter Heather (Todd) Boss, their son Grant, Step-daughter Shannon (Jake) Kramer and their sons, Daniel, Charles and Nicholas Kramer, as well as her loving husband of 22 years, Rev. Johnny Loughridge. Though she has passed, we celebrate in our grief a child of God who made this world better!
