

The third annual Faith Walk will be Sunday, June 19, from 11 am - 4 pm in Mill Point Park (100 Eaton St, Hampton, VA 23669). This event seeks to heal racial injustice in our community. There will be a march from City Hall, guest speakers, children's activities, and information tables from community organizations. SAME will be one of the organizations with an information table, and they would like to offer homemade cookies to everyone who stops by.



Week Of Compassion Heat waves are one of the top three causes of loss of life in the disaster world. Recognizing the signs of heat exhaustion is a way to prevent injuries while at work (reducing the risks of falls and injuries) and fend off heat strokes and other medical emergencies while outdoors. Most at risk are those who work outdoors, the unhoused, elders living alone, and children.

Right now, more than 89Mil in the US are under some level of heat alert. Weather service forecasts this week show temps 10-20deg above normal for most of the US, mid plains to southeast.. Raiza Spratt, Disaster Response Organizer with **Week of Compassion**, offers helpful reminders/resources.

- Give water bottles to folks living on the streets or working outdoors (delivery drivers, construction crews, farm workers). Share in social media the signs of heat-related illness and encourage friends to take it easy those days.
- This is a GREAT time to: Check on your neighbors, especially if they are elderly, in poor health, or living alone.
