

It has been a busy week and we are looking forward to a busy Sunday. October 1 is traditionally World Communion Sunday. In our tradition it is also Reconciliation Sunday; we see communion tied to reconciliation as it is an outward rite that draws us into "communion" with all of God's people. This Sunday will also be the last Silent Sanctuary for 2023. The worship committee will be reassessing how best to

offer contemplative opportunities that reach as many as possible.

On Monday, October 2nd, I will begin a 10 day personal leave time. This is a personal care time for me to regroup and rest as I prepare to lead us through Thanksgiving, Advent, Christmas and the new year.

This personal care time is a gift from you, the congregation. In my contract, I have one day of sick/family/personal leave time for every month I serve. I have used almost none of those days, but I am at a place where I need some personal time to rest. October is the month of the ministry and I see this leave as your gift to me as I care for myself. Caring for myself makes it possible for me to care for the congregation as you need.

While I am out, if a pastoral need arises, contact your parish elder or contact Gina Stump who is chair of the elders. Note: the elders' bulletin board has been updated so if you don't know who your elder is, you can check the board.

Your elder will provide for pastoral needs and if they are unable to do so, they will contact the pastor who is covering in my place. If it is an emergency, I will be contacted. No matter where I am, you all remain in my prayers.

I will be back in time for the Commitment to Community event on Saturday, October 14 and will preach on Sunday, October 15. Remember October 15 is also CROP Walk Sunday.

Thank you again for your gift of time and thank you for your prayers during this self care time.
